Additional Junior Citizen Workshops for Years 5 & 6



A set of additional workshops is now available for schools booking a Y5/6 Junior Citizen tour at Eastside. Developed in partnership with Centro and Birmingham City Council, the aim is to provide children with the skills to travel independently, safely and confidently, especially in the transition to secondary school, and to encourage greener travel choices. Currently available are RoadWise, Using Public Transport and Smarter Travel (journey planning).

Visit arrangements

Schools can book workshops either before or after their main Junior Citizen tour, making the visit into a whole day. We can cater for up to 60 children in workshops at one time. When coupled with the main tour, this

means we can cater for up to 4 classes (120 children) over the day.

Workshops are offered at no additional charge.
