Who Is It For?

NGAGE covers a number of PSHCE/Citizenship objectives at Key Stages 3 and 4 including peer pressure, drugs and alcohol, internet safety, road safety, water safety,

fire safety, consequences of crime, rights and responsibilities and more. It is delivered in an engaging interactive tour in realistic scenarios such as a real street, house, bus, court

room and dark alleyway. There is plenty of opportunity for open questions and discussion. As well as schools it is suitable for youth groups in evenings, weekends and school holidays.



Visit arrangements

NGAGE tours can cater for a minimum of 12 visitors and a maximum of 60. Visits start in our Conference Room with a short introduction. Pupils are then

arranged into smaller groups and each assigned a presenter who will lead them around a different scenario every ten minutes. After the interactive circuit is complete,

groups reassemble for a quiz using electronic voting handsets, to assess and consolidate learning.
